23		The Mind Masters – Thinking Cards Encourage children to ask questions, use multiple perspectives, consider other viewpoints, reflect on their personal thinking dispositions, create deep learning processes and develop meta-cognitive skills.
83		Change by Design Uses questions to challenge us to think about how we can enact shared leadership in our groups, teams, organisations and companies. It is a great tool for keeping fairness alive in the way we participate and include others in any process of change.
102		Making Thinking Visual: Understanding Graphic Organizers Book explains the different uses for the visual tools represented. A set of 18 cards helps facilitate discussions with students about which visual tool might be most appropriate to help represent or analyse an idea. The CD ROM allows students to print off visual tools to assist with the design of their own organisers.
106		And Whether Pigs Have Wings? This resource has three components, a book, a set of cards and a CD ROM. The cards are a set of questions relating to learning strategies. They may be used to scaffold discussions about the use of learning strategies. The CD ROM provides an interactive approach to setting learning goals.
110		There's a Gorilla in My Classroom A set of tools for responding to classroom resistance. It includes a set of 60 cards, 'Resistance Tactics'. These illustrate many classroom behaviors, both pro and anti-learning, depending on the circumstances and a book filled with ideas and activities.



Social Inferences Fun Deck

Social Inferences Fun Deck® with Secret Decoder has 63 social story cards to help students improve their inference-making skills. Students listen to/read the stories and choose the answer that represents a logical inference. There are three social skills sections. Section I asks student to make an inference about the character's personality based on his/her behavior in the scene. Section II asks student to infer how the character in the scene is feeling. Section III asks student to identify the appropriate/inappropriate behavior character is displaying in the scene.

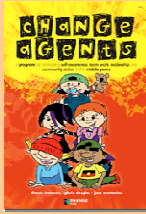
